RESOLUTION NO. 11-121

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF TIGER III APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE HIGHWAY 965 CORRIDOR ENHANCEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of North Liberty is seeking to comprehensively upgrade Highway 965 in cooperation with the City of Coralville from Holiday Road in Coralville north to 230th Street through the City of North Liberty, and

WHEREAS, the City of North Liberty has identified the Highway 965 Corridor Enhancement Project as a priority in the city's approved Capital Improvements Plan; and

WHEREAS, the cities are requesting \$36,257,000 in TIGER III grant funds to complete the project; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Liberty is committed to funding the remaining balance of their portion of the project of \$2,538,000; and

WHEREAS, the City Council provides assurance that it will adequately maintain the completed project for a minimum of twenty years or as long as necessary for the public good.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the North Liberty City Council hereby approves and supports a TIGER III application for said Highway 965 Corridor Enhancement Project.
