New Business:

2. Open to public for comments and concerns. No comments or concerns brought forward.
3. Trees Please Grant – Application is due October 21. Department is interested in using the money to place more trees at Quail Ridge North since this is probably the last year before funds will be used in new park.
4. Tree Board Ordinance: New ordinance was reviewed and discussed. There is some confusion over the most current version of the ordinance. Language will be updated to indicate the board meets quarterly or as needed rather than monthly. At our next meeting we will review another updated version of the ordinance.
5. Storm Water Issues: Discussion and update on Penn Meadows Park Parking lot and Rain Garden project. It is practically done, though there will need to be some re-seeding throughout and some plantings in the roundabout. Pavement will not be cleared of snow in the winter in order to avoid damage. A rainscaping bus tour came through on September 29th and this was some good attention for the project and for the community
6. Cornerstone park will receive some native seed plantings once all the other vegetation is gone, probably around the end of October.
