12:00 pm.

Team Fees: \$90 per team Maximum number of teams: 16 Games played on: Sundays

North Liberty Coed Volleyball League Rules

- Rosters due prior to the first game. Roster changes must be made with the Site Supervisor at the site prior to any game where changes are in effect.
- Players must play in at least <u>Six Games</u> during the regular season games to be eligible for tournament. <u>Players may play for only one team per season</u>. Any team using an illegal player will receive a forfeit for those games.
- Players are not covered by any insurance other than their own personal coverage. It is the team captain's responsibility to inform players.
- A match consists of 3 games, played to 25 points. You must win by 2 unless you get to the max of 32 then the first team to 32 is the winner, rally scoring. All three games are to be played regardless of the results of the first two and count towards the standings. In tournament play we will play best 2 out of 3 games, winner advancing. Volley for serve. Teams call own faults. Games must start on time per rules. Teams must be prepared to exit the court immediately following the match if Rec. Staff is ready take down the nets.
- There is a one-hour time limit per match. If the 3rd game has not yet begun after 45 minutes of play, the score at that time will be the final score. A team will have to forfeit if they are 10 minutes late to their scheduled game.
- Teams play with six players- 3 men, 3 women. Teams must have at least four players to start a match. If they don't have this number they will be required to forfeit a game every 15 minutes that they only have four players. If the other team allows the team with only a few players to begin then we would count the game but that must be decided before the match starts and will be counted in the standings. There may never be more than 3 men on the court at the same time. Teams may play with only one less woman than man. If there are 3 men then 2 women have to play. It is not required that a female contact the ball at any time during the playing of a point.
- If a ball comes in contact with an overhead basketball standard, net or the ceiling, the ball is playable by the offending team. If the ball hits the standard or ceiling and goes over the net it is a side out for the receiving team. If a ball comes in contact with the wall mounted basketball standard, or gym curtain it is considered out of play.
- Scores will be recorded to the site supervisor on duty. Captains are responsible for getting the scores to the site supervisor.
- Two forfeits will result in tournament ineligibility and may result in removal from the league.
- Players may serve from anywhere along the end line and use any part of their body (arms, feet, head, etc.) to contact
 the ball providing it is not a lift or carry.
- In both leagues, the "let serve" rule will be in effect. This means if the serve hits the net and continues over it is a legal serve and should be played. If the ball hits the net and lands out of bounds without being touched, it is a fault and therefore a side-out. **No blocking a serve.**
- Attacking the ball across the plane of the net will not be allowed. You may block the ball over the net on the 3rd hit, but a player may not reach over the net to attack the ball.
- When in doubt replay the point. If there is any disagreement, replay the point.
