

Access for Christine Grant Elementary School and new neighborhood throughway.

Ranshaw House

Renovate house and property to become community space. \$200,000

St. Andrews Drive

Reconstruction from Centennial Park to Kansas Avenue. \$2,200,000

Branding & Visioning

Community conversations leading to new branding and purposeful community vision. \$67,000

Cyber-Security Risk Assessment S22,000

Police Station

Design and construct new station on civic campus site. \$5,000,000

Community Center

Parking lot resurfacing and interior painting. \$66,000






