Monday through Friday, 6am-9pm

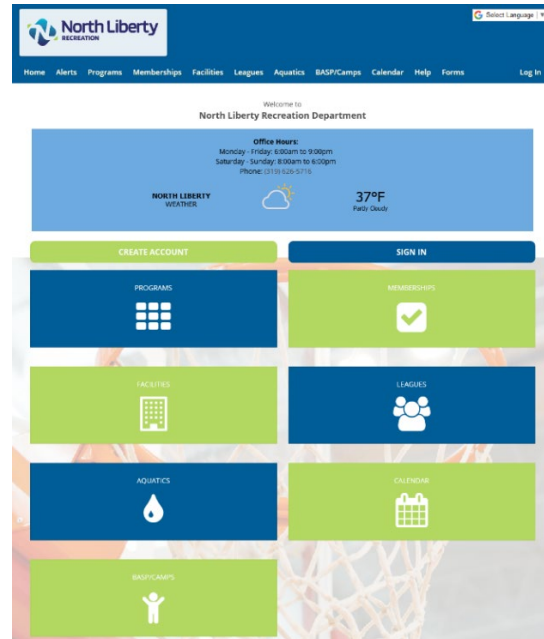
Saturdays & Sundays, 8am-6pm.

Majority of our operations can be found online or can be completed in person. Rec staff are available to help you through this process. If you do not have internet, you can utilize a computer set up in the lobby.

**Program Registration** On-line and in-person registration are available. Please select the **Programs** button, to see programs currently taking registration or in session. Seasonal activity guides are available on-line or in person at the community center; Winter Spring (Jan-April); Summer (May-Aug); Fall (Sept-Dec).

**Membership Use** Facility use is open to members and daily drop-in users. Membership descriptions, rates, and daily fees are listed on reverse side.

**Membership Purchase** Please make sure you have an online account at [northliberty.recdesk.com](http://northliberty.recdesk.com). Once you have an online account you can go to **Memberships**, choose **Category** (Black & Gold, Facility, Gold, Silver or Track), choose **1 month or Annual** option, choose **Description** (Couple, Discounted, Family, or Individual), then click on green **Enroll Now** button and follow steps to make payment and complete transaction. Next time in the facility ask for your ID scan card. Membership cards need to be scanned upon entry with every visit or daily fees will be assessed.

**Financial Assistance** Did you know that financial assistance is offered to North Liberty residents when purchasing memberships or registering for programs. Assistance is granted on the basis of need through the Low-Income Home Energy program. Completed forms are sent to Hawkeye Area Community Action (HACAP) for certification. Once certified, a chart similar to the ICCSD reduced/free lunch program is used to determine free, or percent of fee to be paid. **Indoor Pool** Open for lap swim, scheduled aqua fitness classes and evening swim lessons. Access is inside at front desk. Open swim is Friday, Saturday and Sunday afternoons. **Outdoor Pool** May open Memorial Day Weekend, otherwise summer season will begin first weekend after school is let out - June. Outdoor pool provides morning swim lessons, members access at Noon, and daily drop-in use beginning at 1pm. Access is outside, near concessions window and gate.

## Memberships

The North Liberty Community Center offers a variety of annual and monthly membership packages.

**Black & Gold** includes access to weight and cardio equipment, indoor pool and outdoor pool.

**Gold** includes facility access and weight and cardio equipment use.

**Silver** includes facility access and indoor and outdoor pool use.

**Facility** includes access to open-gym activities such as basketball, pickleball and volleyball.

**Track** includes access to our indoor track.

Residents are those who live within North Liberty's corporate limits. County residents and others outside city limits with a 52317 are classified as non-residents. Please be prepared to show IDs. Financial Aid is available for residents on a sliding scale for annual memberships and programs based on income verified by the HACAP.
